New life is appearing all around us these days. Most of it we love to see: the little yellow flowers in my lawn, not so much. Not everything that grows is good. We need to weed out those things that don't belong. But the yellow flowers are kind of pretty. And little children seem to love them. When young we would pick them and put them under our chins to determine if someone loved us. Of course in the right light they always glow. And by the way someone does always love us. It is not uncommon for us to enjoy some of the things that grow in our lives that shouldn't actually be there. We might even justify their existence. After all if God wanted dandelions out of our lawns He could do that, right. Obviously God leaves it up to us to dig out the undesirable from our own lives. If we don't, those things have a way of just taking over. Have you ever seen a lawn that was never cared for? It is not long before it is a dandelion patch. Why is it that what we don't want in our lives is so fertile?

Anyway, just be aware that all that is growing in your life may not be good for you. We actually need to be very intentional about what we are planting. We have some raised beds in our backyard. They are a great place to raise a few vegetables and even some herbs. We had one bed filled with strawberries. As it grew cold we decided to cover the strawberries with straw. What came up the next year was not what we expected. The bed was filled with weeds and even very aggressive wheat grass. It has taken a few years to overcome a simple mistake. The principle is - plant what you want to grow and avoid planting anything else.

The Lord shares with us a parable regarding our enemy the devil who sneaks into our fields and plants weeds among our good crops. His course of action was to let the weeds grow as destroying the weeds might destroy the crop too. But I am giving you a different principle for a different problem. Letting the weeds grow just equates to the multiplication of the weeds. Pull them out, carefully. And probably do your own gardening in your own life. One step better than having to do a lot of weeding is not allowing the weeds into your life in the first place. Remember this Sunday School song? Probably all we need to live a victorious life we did learn in Sunday School.
