He is Risen!

What a proclamation from the lips of the eyewitnesses to the resurrection of Jesus. It is not just a statement about the life of one man, but about the opportunity for new life for every person who has ever taken breath. The New Testament proclaims that the resurrection of Jesus is the first fruits of all those that sleep (die). 1 Corinthians 15: 20-22

²⁰But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. ²²For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

One truth, clearly visible in the resurrection, is that since God could raise Jesus to life He can raise us too. This is such good news to all of us who know that one day we will also die. In fact the resurrection wouldn't mean anything to us if we weren't going to die.

Paul says that the bad news that came to the human race because of the sin of the first man, is turned to good news by the life and gift of the Lord. We are dead in Adam but alive in Jesus. So when the disciples realized that Jesus was alive, they no longer were afraid of dying. They went from running from the message to running with it.

Without a doubt Easter is the most significant moment in salvation history. The cross is central to our salvation, but without the Resurrection the cross loses its meaning. In the Resurrection, God validates all that Jesus taught and then accomplished on the cross. He has risen = He was right. No other religion can claim that their founder has risen from the dead. No other group of followers was ever so dramatically changed by the news that their leader was alive from the dead. If it

had happened in our day we would have been forever changed by it. But since it did not, we have to be changed by our faith in it.

Jesus said blessed are those who have not seen but have believed because of the witness of those who have. Our power and joy will come in believing the witness of those who saw it. Let us celebrate each Sunday the amazing fact of the Resurrection. It holds for us the sure hope of eternal life. PK

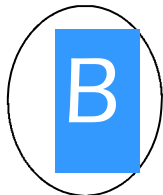

Kiss your insecurities good-bye and discover the joy of living with confidence!

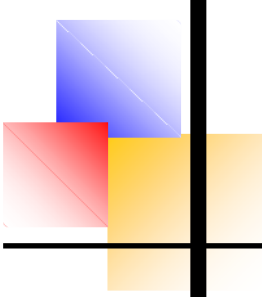
